
Ms. DeHaan contributes all general and administrative costs. Consequently, 100% of all donations fund programs directly benefitting the Christel House children.

Funds are raised in a variety of ways, such as art auctions featuring works by Christel House children like the ones shown at right. Another major method of raising money is by means of the Christel House Open, a unique golf tournament that is actually a series of tournaments.

This year thirty "Tier One" tournaments were held on five continents in ten countries. The winning team from each site qualified to compete in the World Championship, to be held this September in Indianapolis, Indiana – "the amateur sports capitol of the world". Immediately following will be the LPGA's prestigious Solheim Cup international tournament held in Indy, to which World Championship contestants will be awarded tickets and other special privileges.

We are proud to announce that the Christie Lodge volunteered to be the host sponsor for one of the thirty Tier One tournaments. It took place at the Cotton Ranch Club in



Gypsum, Colorado. Gypsum is about thirty miles west of the Lodge and only a couple of miles from the Eagle airport.

Friday or Saturday Check-in Policy to be Tested

Breaking news is at the Lodge! We are planning to test a policy to give you a choice of Friday or Saturday arrival in a test period in 2005!

From time to time our Owners have requested that the Lodge consider allowing owners a choice of a Friday, Saturday or Sunday check-in day for the start of their owner week.

After careful review of potential problems we have decided to implement a trial period offering owners booking weeks 2~50 a choice of a Friday or Saturday check-in day for the start of their seven day vacation week.

Since weeks 51 and 52 are fixed weeks and units, we will not be able to accommodate a Sunday check-in for certain weeks at either end of the calendar as the end of these weeks would flow into the start of a fixed week. We will monitor the bookings closely for potential problems. In the event we feel the option is creating inventory problems we reserve the right to discontinue the option without notice.



You asked and we listened! By popular demand we will test-implement a more flexible check-in period!

We will use the Christie Lodge website to update you on the progress of the test period. If we discontinue the program we will also advise owners as they are booking their week.

We hope this will provide additional flexibility for you and give you more opportunities to fully enjoy your Christie Lodge ownership by staying with us.

Board members are limited to two consecutive terms. There is

also a rule that says no more than three members can be from any one state.



Club Navigo Discontinued

Effective immediately the Internal Club Navigo exchange option for our owners is discontinued. A few of our owners took advantage of this exchange option but the program was not utilized to the extent we had desired and anticipated.

We are currently entering into a sales agreement to sell the Christie Lodge owned inventory, explained at left, and these two programs would be in direct conflict.

Christie management will continue to look for additional programs that provide additional benefits and flexibility for our owners.





In response to your questions and needs we have compiled the following list of various options available to you, our valued owners and guests, to keep you connected via the World Wide Web. We understand your need to stay in-touch via the web and be productive. Our in-house service provider provides you the convenience of 24 hour DSL High Speed Internet Access with several options.

- You may use **the Kiosk in our atrium** for a flat rate of \$.25 per minute (4 minute minimum). Prepay 30 minutes for 30% off and 1 hour for 40% off. There is no need to use all your time at once. Create a login and password and use your time as you wish during your stay or at any other SurfNet terminal nationwide. This is an ideal situation for quick access to your email and includes video and voice email capabilities. Major credit cards (\$3 minimum) and cash bills (\$1 minimum) are accepted for payment. No change is given.
- With your own Wi-Fi enabled Mobile Device or Wireless Laptop you can take advantage of our "**AIRPATH wireless Hotspot**" emanating *within line of sight of our Kiosk*. Sit back in our comfortable common area or conference rooms, even warm up to the fire, and get your tasks done wirelessly at high speed. An hour minimum charge of \$3.95 applies. You may also choose from a daily rate of \$7.95 or monthly at \$24.95.
- **Dial-up service** is available to laptop users from your room for a \$0.55 connect fee plus any applicable long distance charges.

• COPY COPY PRINT SHOP

(Open 7:30am to 8pm Monday thru Friday, 9am to 6pm on Saturdays and noon to 6pm on Sundays) Just across

the street is our local print shop with a business center and Internet access available to you at a flat rate of \$1.00 for every 5 minutes (\$12 per hour). Here you have access to their PCs or connect your laptop via Ethernet connection. This situation is also ideal for word-processing and printing needs.



• SLICK RICK'S OCEANSIDE INTERNET CAFÉ

(Open 8:30am to 9pm Monday thru Friday, 9:30am to 9pm on Saturdays, noon to 6pm on Sundays) Located here in Avon this is a true Internet café where an hour's minimum on their computers gets you a piping hot coffee. 15 minutes is just \$2.00, \$20.00 daily, \$50.00 per week and \$75.00 per month.

• AVON PUBLIC LIBRARY

(Open 8:30am to 9pm Monday thru Friday, 9:30am to 9pm on Saturdays, noon to 6pm on Sundays) With a valid ID you can apply for a library card or Internet card which authorizes you to use their FREE Internet access for as much as two 30 minutes sessions per day. Advance reservations may be required.

We are proud to note that the Christie Lodge is now internationally recognized on the world wide web at numerous Wi-Fi Hot Spot search engines as a wireless Internet provider. These search engines are available at such sites as: USA TODAY, FORBES, INTEL, YAHOO, etc. Most importantly we are mentioned at the primary search engine called JIWIRE.COM which hosts seamless searches from hundreds of other sites.
