



Property Updates

Our new Tropitone furniture adds a great pop of color and comfort. You'll find the new swivel/rocking chairs, tables and sofas by the pool and game areas, at the Subway restaurant and in various locations throughout the common areas.

ADA Compliance Update

We continue to make progress towards completion of our ADA plan. We have currently installed Braille signage throughout the property and have two assistive device kits available for guest use. The kits contain a TTY text/telephone for the hearing impaired, a telephone amplifier, an audio/visual smoke detector and an ADA compliance door sign. They also contain a bed shaker, wireless door knocker, telephone and alarm clock alert system and a remote receiver which indicates activity in another room within your unit. Additional ADA enhancements are the ramps connecting the east and west wings of the building and the renovation of our elevators. The ramps will not only assist our ADA owners and guests but will also provide ease in transporting your luggage. The are open for use and we expect that the carpeting will be installed by Friday, July 26th, which will complete that project. The refurbishment of the elevator cabs will include new wall panels, lighting, carpeting and floor number buttons in Braille. This project is scheduled to be completed in August.
