PROJECT UPDATES AT THE LODGE

"PROJECT WOW" is in full swing and is anticipated to be complete by June 2018. The Christie Lodge Management Team is making every effort to maintain your satisfaction and comfort during your stay. There are a limited amount of these units available for occupancy at this time but upon completion we anticipate that everyone will be in complete "WOW" of the work accomplished.

This exciting renovation encompasses many changes to the units including new wood flooring, six-panel doors, a kitchen remodel featuring new cabinets with a Lazy Susan, a full size refrigerator/freezer combo and a cook-top. The remodeled bathroom has a new vanity, glass shower doors and towel racks. These improvements also have enhanced storage, including almost 25% more kitchen cabinet space and additional shelving in the hallway and the bathroom vanity.

Units are being re-configured so that beds will be moved away from the wall and allow entry from both sides. The popcorn ceilings will be removed and then textured.

In addition, all of the units will feature a desk and chair. The Christie Lodge is one of the most popular lodging choices in the Vail Valley and these room upgrades will be sure to have owners and guests feeling as if they are right at home while they enjoy their time in the mountains.

RED FLAG WARNING!

RESCUE & TRANSFER COMPANIES

Potentially fraudulent sales offers typically contain certain red flags!

Please take caution if any of the following promises are made:

•If you are told a buyer is waiting to purchase your timeshare.

•If you are offered cash for your week, only to find out you have to pay funds in advance

to use their sales program.

•If you are told your week is guaranteed to sell.

•If you are required to sign a power of attorney.

•If you are asked for your bank information.

Did you know it is fraudulent to intentionally transfer out of a credit obligation in Colorado? A recently enacted Colorado law helps protect consumers against these types of activities.



Avon, A Look Back.... Then & Now



"Checkmate"

From homesteaders, lettuce fields and a bridge named "Bob", to the 2015 FIS World Ski Championships, Avon has come a long way! Once regarded as a bedroom community for local workers and a gateway to Vail, Avon has transitioned into a world-class vacation destination at the base of Beaver Creek Mountain. The Town of Avon has worked tirelessly to create beautifully landscaped spaces, a pedestrian-friendly downtown with 29 bronze sculptures along its Art Walk, new biking trails, a new concert pavilion at Nottingham Park and has welcomed new lodging developments and a variety of new businesses.

Our long-time owners, Byron and Connie Zirkle, provided the above photo of Avon, which was taken in 1985 looking to the southwest from the Christie Lodge. The Zirkles purchased a blue week and a white week in June of 1985 and had their first stay in September of 1985. Byron shared that one of his memories from their first stay was that the lodge was experiencing problems with the fire alarms. He chuckled as he recalled getting the emergency ladder out of the closet several times, even though it was announced that there was not a fire in the building. He also recalled the Avon Town Council's Name the Bridge Contest when the name "Bob" was chosen from 84 entries. Over the years Byron & Connie have enjoyed their vacations at the lodge and the opportunity to visit many surrounding places of interest.
