Annual Owners Meeting



2017 Christie Lodge Annual Owners Meeting

Management would like to thank Fort Worth, TX, for such a warm welcome during the 2017 Annual Owners Meeting, held on September 30th at Radisson Ft. Worth North at Fossil Creek. During the Board of Directors meeting, routine annual business of the association was conducted and Mr. Ted Langworthy and Mr. John Mertens were elected to the Board of Directors and Mr. Bill McReynolds was re-elected to the Board of Directors.

Ms. Siegert-Free, Managing Director and General Manager, presented information about the newly added year-round, daily service to Eagle County Regional Airport from Dallas/ Ft. Worth airport. She also presented a comparison of owner maintenance fee costs to the industry average, noting that Christie Lodge fees are significantly lower than other resorts. In addition, Ms. Siegert-Free presented Christie Lodge customer ratings for the past three years and how the positive comments could attract new buyers.

Our sales company partner, Trucation, is staffed and they are excited for the coming ski season. Ms. Siegert-Free added that Vail Resorts acquired Stowe Mountain Resort for a purchase price of \$41M.

Mr. Dameron, Executive Director of Operations, provided information on current renovations and improvements at the lodge. Mr. Dameron also gave an update on the parking lots which had the asphalt removed, replaced and restriped in front of the building. He then added that Beaver Creek Boulevard is scheduled to be redesigned by the Town of Avon next summer. Rick also informed the owners that ARDA continues to fight fraud of timeshare relief rescue companies. He thanked the owners for their support and encouraged them to return to The Christie Lodge to see and experience the renovations and upgrades.

Management presented information to owners about two proposed amendments to the association bylaws, Amendments 6 and 7. Ms. Siegert-Free explained to the owners, that there are owners renting their units on a nightly basis through Airbnb and VRBO. These types of rentals are not being communicated to the association and can causes logistical challenges for the front desk and housekeeping, as well as added security concerns. Since these shorter stays require additional housekeeping service, they increase the costs to the association and can adversely affect our overall ratings. The Board President, Mr. J. Raymond David, reminded owners that ratings affect your timeshare's trading value. With Amendment 6 in place, owners will be able to rent out their units but will not be allowed to split the week between multiple renters. Amendment 6 exempts families, and does not affect bonus nights. Ms. Siegert-Free reminded attendees that the association has a rental program available to owners wanting to rent their week.

Amendment 7 amends the language in the Condominium Declaration to be consistent with the language in the Commercial Unit Rules and Regulations which requires prior approval by the board for a commercial unit to be divided or subdivided into smaller units, or any portion sold or otherwise transferred.

The owners agreed that Amendments 6 and 7 would benefit the association and cast their ballots in favor of this addition to the Condominium Declarations. Owners and Management expressed their thanks and appreciation for the efforts, experience and dedication that the Directors bring to the Christie Lodge.

The next CLOA Annual Owners meeting will be held on **Saturday, October 13, 2018** at the Christie Lodge in Avon, Colorado.

Bonus Nights and Bonus Weeks

Bonus nights must be reserved by the owner on the deed and may only be used by immediate family: mother father, sons, or daughters. Room availability is based on excess inventory and may be requested 30 days or less, prior to the arrival date. If we do not have bonus night availability, the reservation team will check renta availability, and if available, will offer you a significant discount off our lowest published rental rate. Bonus night rates start as low as \$60 per night for a one bedroom and \$90 for a three bedroom. An extended bonus night program is also available that includes brothers, sisters and grandchildren.

Gifting Your Week

Your week may be gifted or shared with friends and family at no additional cost! To gift a week, please notify reservations and they will add your guest(s) to the reservation. Your week includes a midweek service and additional housekeeping services are available for a fee.

As always, please know you can book your contract week up to 360 days prior to arrival. This can be done in the reservations office, on the owners' website, or by calling us at 888-325-6343. Availability is limited and if you exchange your week, trading power can be affected by how far in advance your week is deposited with the exchange company. It is recommended to reserve as soon as possible.

SCAM INFO: BEWARE Once again a new scam has surfaced! Owners are being targeted with the lure of an easy, up-front fee to exit their timeshare commitment and are told that an attorney can help get them out of their timeshare obligations. When an owner makes contact with the scam company, they are then instructed not to communicate with the resort. They are told an attorney will work on their behalf to relieve them of all their obligations. Once this happens, the owner in many cases does not get help from the attorney and has paid legal fees that they cannot get back. Don't fall into this trap! Always call your resort first to see if there are solutions to your situation. Please call us if you have any questions!

The Christie Lodge in Avon, Colorado, was built in 1980, and offered its first vacation ownership product two years later. Winter Happenings



Vail

Vail Resorts continues its wave of tremendous investments at Vail Mountain with the replacement of the Northwoods Express Lift with a six-passenger lift. The new lift reduces wait times, increases capacity by 25 percent, and improves the flow of skiers and snowboarders to the legendary Back Bowls and Blue Sky Basin throughout the day, including end of day, which will create a better flow of traffic exiting Blue Sky Basin and moving across the mountain.

Beaver Creek

Beaver Creek Resort upgraded the Drink of Water Lift from a two-person fixed grip lift to a new highspeed quad and was renamed the Red Buffalo Express.

The new Red Buffalo Express was named after the beginner Red Buffalo trail. The new lift reduces ride time by 50 percent, from 8.6 minutes to 4.3 minutes, and increases uphill capacity by 75 percent.
